ORAL ORDER

3 03-11-2015 After some argument, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, in presence of the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to file an appeal before the appellate authority prescribed under the provisions of The Bihar Land Disputes Resolution Act, 2009 against the impugned order dated 8.11.2012 (Annexure-2) passed by the respondent D.C.L.R., Dehri, Rohtas.
