ORAL ORDER

3 04-03-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

The petitioners seek bail in connection with Kuchaikote (Gopalganj) P.S. Case No. 218 of 2014 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 324, 307, 379 and 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the case. They are agnates of the informant and due to petty dispute the alleged incident is said to have taken place.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer for bail. He has submitted that the petitioners are alleged to have

brutally assaulted the informant, his brother and his daughter with *lathi* as a result of which, the daughter of the informant died on the spot and the two others were taken to hospital for treatment.

Learned counsel for the informant has also supported the contention of learned counsel for the State. He has submitted that the injury reports of the two injured and the postmortem report of the deceased duly corroborates ocular version of the informant as recorded in the first information report.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, their prayer for bail is rejected.
