Heard the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in a criminal prosecution registered under Sections 341, 323, 448, 380, 354, 436 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted that the petitioner and the informant are relation and now the matter has been compromised between the parties and accordingly a compromise petition has been filed in the court below. It is further highlighted that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 07.08.2014.

Taking the aforesaid aspects into consideration, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is allowed. The above named petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Madhubani in connection with Bifsi (Patauna) P.S.Case No. 197 of 2014, subject to the following conditions:

(A) one of the bailors must be government servant or close family member or close relation of the petitioner who will file an affidavit in the court below showing

his/her relationship with the petitioner,
(B) if the petitioner is found involved in same and similar nature of cases in future, then in that case, the informant/prosecution shall be at liberty to file a petition for cancellation of bail of the petitioner, and if such a petition is filed, the court below would be obliged to dispose of the same in accordance with law after giving opportunity of hearing to all concerned, and
(C) the petitioner shall make regular pairvi in the court below in the present case either by appearing himself in person or through representation by his lawyer on each and every dates, and if on two consecutive dates petitioner fails to make pairvi, then the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
