Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and
the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
29.09.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 395, 397 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant was robbed while taking cash
to the bank. Name of the petitioner sprang up on confession of co-
accused.

Statements have been made in para 14 and 15
of the petitioner neither the petitioner has been put on TIP nor any
recovery has been made from the petitioner. A statement has been
made in para 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal

antecedent whereas learned Sessions’s Judge order suggests that the petitioner has criminal antecedent.

Considering the fact that petitioner has not been put on TIP, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Muzaffarpur in connection with Muzaffarpur P.S. Case No. 697 of 2014, **but the petitioner will not be released, if the court from the case diary comes to a finding that the petitioner has criminal antecedent.**
