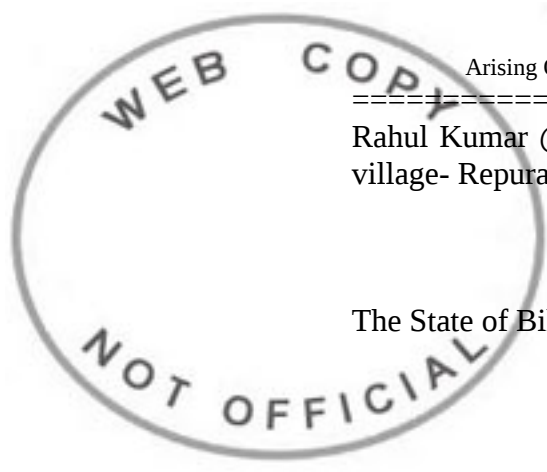

Heard learned counsel for the Petitioners and the State.

The Petitioners seek revision of the Judgment in
Appeal dated 28.2.2015 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge-IV,
Nalanda at Biharsharif in Criminal Appeal No. 02 of 2015 by which

their conviction under Section 414 Indian Penal Code and Provisions of the Arms Act have been maintained with maximum punishment of two years and a fine of Rs.1,000/- in default of which 15 days rigorous imprisonment.

It has been submitted that the Petitioners have remained in custody for about 15 months as stated in paragraph-20 and XI of the petitions.

However, having gone through the impugned Judgment, I do not find any merit in the revision, the same is dismissed with modification in sentence to the period already undergone by them.
