ORAL ORDER

2 19-01-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Section 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the accompanying documents, let the
petitioner above named, who has fair antecedents, be released on
anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the
learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of
receipt of this order in connection with Complaint case No.721C
of 2013 on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.5,000/- (five thousand)
with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
C.J.M., Bettiah, West Champaran, subject to the conditions as laid

down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as also conditions (i) That one of the bailor will be a close relative of the petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the petitioner. The bailor will undertake to furnish information to the Court about any change in address of the petitioner. (ii) That the affidavit shall clearly state that the petitioner is not an accused in any other case and if he is he shall not be released on bail, (iii) That the bailor shall also state on affidavit that he will inform the court concerned if the petitioner is implicated in any other case of similar nature after his release in the present case and thereafter the court below will be at liberty to initiate the proceeding for cancellation of bail on ground of misuse, (iv) That the petitioner will be well represented on each date if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail will be liable to be cancelled.
