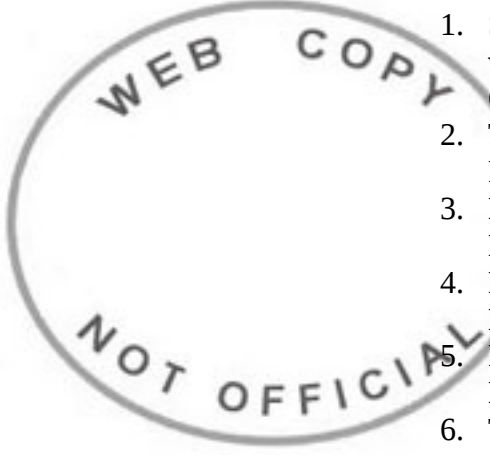

ORAL ORDER

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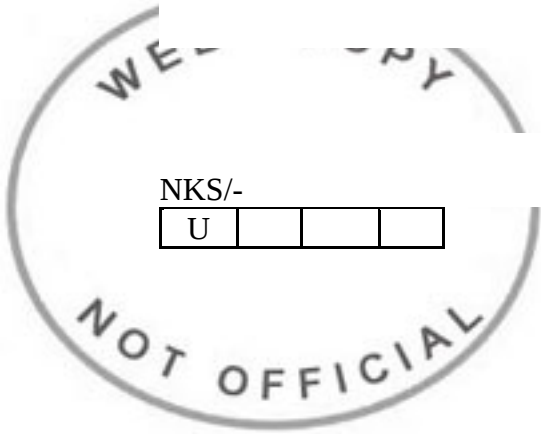
4 27-04-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
