4 09-09-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned A.P.P. for the State as also the learned counsel for the complainant-opposite party no.2.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Complaint Case No.216 of 2014 registered under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code besides Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner happens to be the husband of the complainant-opposite party no.2 and has falsely been implicated in this case due to misunderstanding. It is further submitted that the petitioner is still ready to keep the complainant-opposite party no.2 with full honour and dignity. The petitioner is in jail custody since 17.01.2015.

Having regard to the facts and the circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Banka, in connection with Complaint Case No.216 of 2014.
