3 07-09-2015 Heard both sides.

The petitioners seek bail in a case under Section 302
and other sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law
of the deceased. The father of the deceased Remi Devi made
allegation that his daughter was killed by her husband, father-in-
law, mother-in-law and brother-in-law and her dead body was left
at the house of Indal Yadav. Pinki Devi, sister-in-law of the
deceased, disclosed that mother-in-law Draupdi Devi, brother-in-
law Akhilesh Yadav and husband Bhavesh Yadav brought the
dead body of the deceased on an auto-rickshaw and dropped the
same in her courtyard. Pinki Devi did not disclose the name of
petitioner no. 2 who is the father-in-law of the deceased. There is

omnibus and general allegation against the petitioners.

Considering the facts aforesaid and the fact that the petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law of the deceased who are in custody for about eight months, the above named petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M. 1st Class, Purnea, Dist. Purnea in Sarsi P.S. Case No. 15 of 2015.
