Heard the parties.

The petitioner has filed the present writ petition seeking a direction to the respondents to give him benefit of pay scale of Rs. 4000-6000/-, which was notified by the District Magistrate, Madhepura vide letter dated vide letter dated 12.07.2011.

A counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of the respondents on 14th January, 2015. In paragraph-7 of the aforesaid counter-affidavit it has been stated that during the pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner has already been paid an amount of Rs. 2,08, 812/- on 30.06.2014 vide two separate bills. In paragraph-10 of the aforesaid counter-affidavit it has further been stated that the benefit of the pay scales of Rs. 4000- 6000/- has also been paid to the petitioner. Therefore, according to the respondents, the grievances raised on behalf of the petitioner have been redressed.

The writ petition stands disposed of as infructuous as the grievances of the petitioner have already been redressed in view of the averments made on behalf of the respondents in the counter-affidavit filed on their behalf,.
