Petitioner is languishing in jail custody since 10-05-2014
in a case registered under Section-392 of the Indian Penal Code on
the accusation that looted motorcycle was recovered from his
possession but submission on behalf of the petitioner is that when
the informant was examined before the trial court, the informant
could not identify the petitioner.
