2 20-08-2015 Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner being rice miller, failed to deliver rice as per agreement executed between the BSFC as well as the petitioner and allegedly, he defalcated the government money to the tune of Rs. 6455231/-

The contention on behalf of the petitioner is that even if, prosecution story assumed to be true, then also, it is only a case of breach of agreement and moreover, several co-accused of different cases, having similar allegation, have already been granted privilege of bail by different benches of this court.

Accordingly, the petitioner named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Arwal P.S. Case No. 82 of 2015 to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Arwal.
