5 14-12-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner happens to be husband of the informant
against whom there is specific allegation that he made illegal
demand and pushed the informant from roof as a result of which,
the informant sustained grievous injury on the legs.

The contention on behalf of the petitioner is that the
informant was discharged from the hospital on 25-06-2015 but it
is surprising enough that she gave written report to Officer-in-
charge of concerned Police Station on 24-06-2015.

Although, learned counsel for the petitioner tried to
convince me about the false implication of the petitioner but I am

not at all convinced with the above-stated submissions and in my view, the petitioner does not deserve the privilege of bail, at least, at this stage and, accordingly, his prayer for bail in connection with Guruwa P.S. Case No. 113 of 2015 pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Gaya stands rejected.
