2 24-09-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is named in the first information report but according to prosecution case itself, the petitioner was neither director of the aforesaid company nor he issued either bonds or cheques, in question. Moreover, co-accused, Sudhir Kumar, having similar type of allegation, has already been granted privilege of bail by a coordinate bench of this court.
