It is submitted that there is no eye witness of the

Learned counsel for the informant very fairly submitted that except suspicion there is no material.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the petitioner above named is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nawada in Pakaribarawan P.S. Case No. 212 of 2014.
