ORAL ORDER

3 04-02-2015 The petitioners are facing allegation under Sections- 307, 341, 342, 324, 337 and 338/34 of I.P.C. in Baisi P.S. Case No.65 of 2014, on the file of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purnea.

Apprehending arrest, the petitioners filed A.B.P. No.665 of 2014 on the file of learned Sessions Judge, Purnea. The learned Judge rejected the application through order dated 21.7.2014. Hence, this application for grant of anticipatory bail under Section- 438 of Cr.P.C.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned A.P.P. for the State.

A perusal of the F.I.R. discloses that the names of several accused were mentioned and only an omnibus allegation was made. No specific act attributed. At any rate, no serious injury is mentioned, much less it is stated that the complainant was hospitalized. As such, the Court is convinced that the petitioners deserve to be granted anticipatory bail. The application is allowed.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail upon furnishing the bail-bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) along with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purnea, in connection with Baisi P.S. Case No.65 of 2014, subject to the conditions laid down under Section-438(2) of Cr.P.C.
