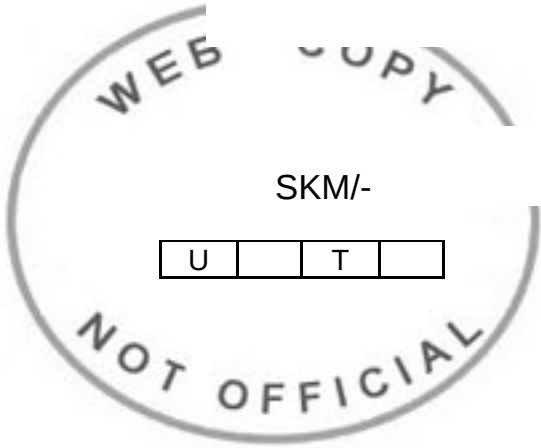

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Looking at the nature of allegation with no clear evidence, even being discussed in the order of rejection of learned Sessions Judge, Gaya, despite F.I.R. having been instituted more than a year ago, anticipatory bail application of the petitioner is allowed.

Let the petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 20,000/- (twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Smt. Anindita Singh, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Gaya, in connection with Khizor Sarai Police Station Case No. 53 of 2014 (G.R. No. 1933 of 2014), which shall be abide by

the terms and conditions mentioned in sub-section (2) of section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
