counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail
in connection with Complaint Case No. 1738 of 2013.

In the complaint petition, there is an allegation of
torture and enter into 2nd marriage.

The counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention to
Annexure-4 which shows that parties have settled the dispute and
the payment was also made.

In such view of the matter, in the event of the
petitioner's arrest or surrender before the court below within four

weeks from the date of communication of this order, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar in connection with Complaint Case No. 1738 of 2013, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr. P.C. and any observation made in the order will not prejudice either to the petitioner or to the O.P.No. 2 during the trial.
