ORAL ORDER

4 03-04-2015 The petitioner has expressed imminent threat to his life at the hands of some antisocial elements. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that there is District Level Security Committee in each district to consider threat perception of a person for providing police protection.

In that view of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw this application with liberty to file an appropriate representation before the District Level Security Committee within two weeks from today.

Leave is granted.

In case, such a representation is filed within two weeks from today, the District Level Security Committee shall consider the same without any undue delay and dispose of the same preferable within six weeks from the date of filing of the representation.

It is to be noted here that the petitioner has also expressed willingness to pay cost of the bodyguard in case it is provided by the District Level Security Committee.

With this observation, the application is disposed of.
