The writ application has been filed for restoring the shop/Gumti to the petitioner who was running his business as a cobbler in the Gumti (wooden kiosk).

The State-respondent has pointed out that with the consent of the shopkeeper(s) and others the Gumtis/kiosks were removed and pucca construction was made and thereafter applications were invited wherein the petitioner also applied. The shop was not allotted to him on various grounds.

Be that as it may, since the petitioner defaulted in appearance at least on two consecutive dates, the application is dismissed for want of prosecution.
