ORAL ORDER

2 26-03-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 379, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 3(1)(x) of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

The accusations are of assaulting the informant with iron rod, fists, kicks, lathi, abusing by calling caste name and snatching Rs. 2500/-.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the occurrence is of 29.10.2014 and F.I.R. was registered on 23.12.2014 and there is no injury report on the record which has been also

recorded by learned Sessions Judge in the impugned order which reads as follows:-

"Injury report is not available in the case diary."

Considering delayed lodging of the case, statement made in paragraph no. 3 of the petition that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent and injury report being not on the record, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today in connection with Gopalganj (SC/ST) P.S. Case No. 64 of 2014 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Gopalganj, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
