learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail
arises out of Begusarai Muffasil P.S. Case No. 348 of
2014, disclosing offences under Sections 302/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is named accused in the First
Informant Report. This case being a case instituted under
Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, I am not inclined to
grant the petitioner the privilege of anticipatory bail.

This application for anticipatory bail is, accordingly, rejected.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the court below within six weeks and seek regular bail, if so advised. If he does so, his application for regular bail shall be considered on its own merit without being prejudiced by rejection of present application for grant of anticipatory bail.
