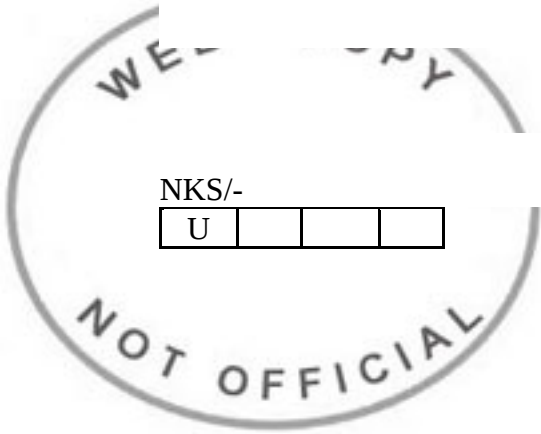

Learned AC to SC-8 by way of referring to counter affidavit filed on behalf of Respondent nos.1,3 and 4, which was filed on 11th November, 2008 submits that the claim for grant of 1st and 2nd time bound promotion has already been granted.
