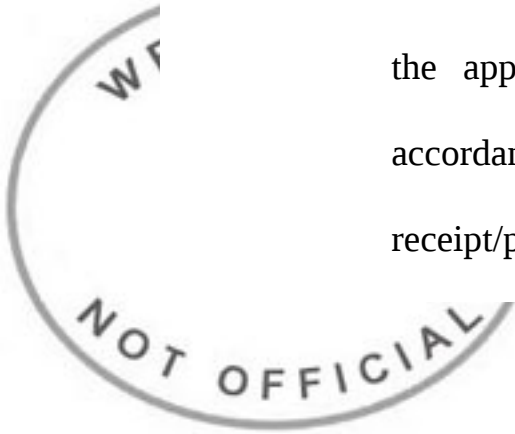
ORAL JUDGMENT

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

It is contended on behalf of the petitioner that though application for grant of arms licence for carrying N.P. Bore Revolver/Pistol was filed in the year 2005 itself vide Annexure 1, no decision has been taken by the authority concerned despite the recommendation by the police officer on 20.12.2005 vide Annexure 2. If the allegation of the petitioner is correct, then this appears to be gross negligence on part of the respondents.

Be that as it may, this writ application is being disposed of with a direction to the licensing authority to take a decision on the application of the petitioner on its own merit and in accordance with law within eight weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
