Writ application is dismissed for the reason that there is no correlation between the petitioner, the State of Bihar or State Health Society. The service is being provided by Dr Jain Video on wheels Limited to the State Health Society and payment for the service is being made to the said organization. What transpires between the provider of the service and the people so hired by the

service provider including the present petitioner, who happens to be an Ambulance Driver, does not come within the ambit of Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

Writ is dismissed.
