ORAL ORDER

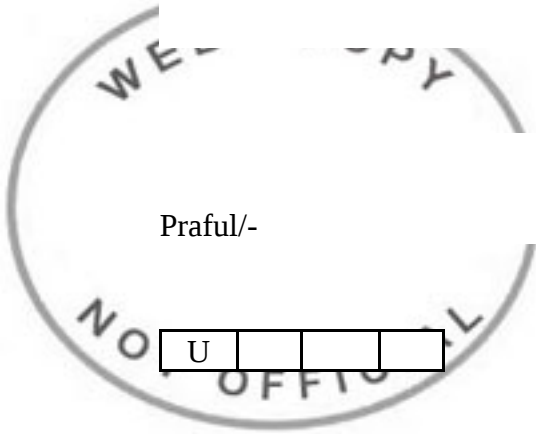
