ORAL ORDER

Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Complaint
Case No. 1319 of 2013, registered for the offences punishable
under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he took Rs. 2
Lacs from the complainant on assurance to sell the house. An
agreement to sale was also executed and the house was sold to the
complainant. Thereafter, the petitioner again took Rs. 2 Lacs for
treatment of his wife but the petitioner did not return and a cheque
was also returned on the ground that the signature did not tally.

Having considered the facts aforesaid and the fact

that this is a simple case of lending money, the petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Shri A. Shamim, the learned Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Complaint Case No. 1319 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
