Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with
Singheshwar P.S. Case No. 110 of 2005 registered under Sections-
376, 420, 342, 467, 468, 386, 315, 120(B) of the Indian Penal
Code.

There is allegation against this petitioner that he
committed rape upon the informant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
case has already been compromised between the parties. It is
obvious from perusal of the impugned order of learned Sessions
Judge that the charge sheet has already been submitted and,
therefore, I do not feel it proper to grant privilege of anticipatory
bail to the petitioner and accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail

of the petitioner stands rejected.

However, if the petitioner surrenders before the court below and seeks regular bail within two weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of the order, the concerned court shall consider the regular bail application of the petitioner on its own merit without being prejudiced by this order, particularly, keeping in mind the factum of compromise between the parties.
