02 09-06-2015 The petitioner who is the husband apprehends his arrest
in Complaint Case No.1745 of 2013 instituted under Section-498
A/34 of the Indian Penal Code on behest of her wife. They were
married more than five years back and have two children.

On behalf of the petitioner, it is submitted that he has
also filed a suit for restitution of conjugal rights as the wife is not
ready to live and perform his social obligation.

Be that as it may, in the event of arrest or surrender
within four weeks from today, the petitioner, namely, Najir
Hussain alias Md. Najir Hussain, shall be released on bail on

furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar in connection with Complaint Case No.1745 of 2013, subject to all conditions as laid down in Section-438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code.
