Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376/511, 450 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of entering into the house of the informant and attempting to establish forceful physical relationship.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is the brother-in-law (dewar) of the informant. For the occurrence of 02.09.2013, the complaint was filed on 05.09.2013 which came to be registered as a police case after being transferred under Section 156(3) of the Cr. P.C. on 16.09.2013.

Considering the delayed lodging of the FIR and

litigated relationship between the parties, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Sitamarhi in connection with Runnisaidpur P.S. Case No. 362 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
