Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Merely because the private-respondent was said to be less than 17 years of age at the time of her appointment as Anganbari Sevika, it does not mean that her subsequent selection on the post of Supervisor also becomes illegal.

The impugned order, contained in Annexure- 6, has only reiterated a legal position, which has already been held so, in series of decisions rendered by this Court.

That is the only ground on which the impugned order is being assailed. There is no infirmity in the impugned order, dated 12.04.2013, passed by the Collector, Jamui in Case No. 6 of 2013.

Writ application has no merit, it is dismissed.
