Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner is apprehending arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 452,380,384,504 and
506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the petitioner being nephew of the
informant got a will executed by the husband of the informant and
by virtue of the will he was ploughing the land of the informant.
Subsequently on 14.12.2014 the petitioner along with other
unidentified persons entered into the house of informant and
committed theft of rupees one lac cash, ear ring and documents of
the land.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner
that the probate case is pending between the parties and in the
background of pendency of probate case no.26 of 2014 filed by
the wife of the petitioner the present

accusation has been levelled. Statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Samastipur in connection with Patory P.S. Case No. 20 of 2015 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
