ORAL ORDER

8 06-02-2015 No one appears on behalf of the opposite party despite repeated call.

The petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 18.01.2012 passed by the Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Patna in Maintenance Case No. 73(M) of 2007 by which he has allowed an amount of Rs. 4,000/- per month as maintenance to her from the date of filing of the application.

The petitioner submits that in view of the salary of the opposite party to the tune of Rs. 25,000/- per month at the time of filing of the application, she should have been getting Rs. 16,000/- per month. Now the salary has been increased to 50,000/-.

Considering that there is no dispute with regard to the

petitioner being wife of the opposite party nor that she is unable to maintain herself or that she is refusing to live with him without any reasonable cause, the application is allowed.

The Bank authorities are directed to remit 1/3 of the pay in hand which the opposite party receives every month, to the Bank Account of the petitioner bearing Account No. 0600010178051 United Bank, Lohianagar Branch, Kankarbagh, Patna.

Let this order be communicated to the Branch Manager, Dena Bank, Dwarika, Delhi.

With these observations the application stands allowed.
