State.

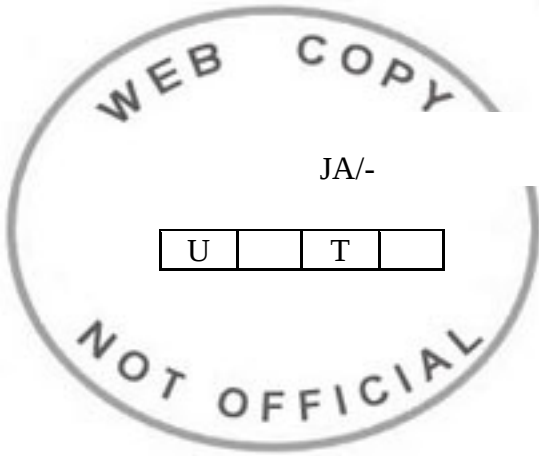
Petitioner seeks bail in Laximpur P.S. Case No. 192
