The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in
connection with Sadar P.S. Case No.372 of 2008 for allegedly
having committed the offence under Section 302 and other allied
Sections of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms
Act.

After perusing the F.I.R. and noticing that these
petitioners have no specific role to play, as alleged, let all the
three petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or
surrender before the court below within a period of three weeks

from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Smt. Niharika, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Vaishali at Hajipur, in connection with Complaint Case No.2824/2011 (Tr. No.3621/2013), arising out of Sadar P.S. Case No.372 of 2008, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
