State.

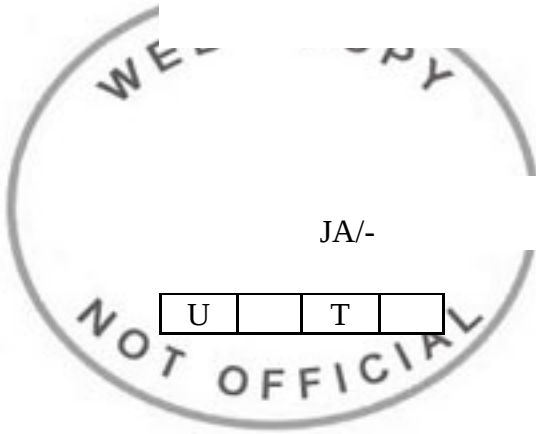
The Petitioner seeks bail in Adapur P.S. Case No.
