2 21-09-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the

State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 337, 338, 353, 307, 427, 379, 120B of the Indian Penal Code, section 27 of the Arms act, sections 4/40 of the Bihar Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1972 and sections 3,41 and 42 of the Indian Forest Act.

It is alleged that the truck loaded with stone chips was intercepted and finding that it was being transported without valid authority, it was being taken to the police station when the mob attacked the informant, pelted stones and resorted to fire. The informant also fired from service revolver to disperse the crowd

but the informant and other police personnel sustained injuries.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the FIR has been lodged against 52 named and 30-35 unknown. The accusation is omnibus and general. It is further submitted that statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Rohtas in connection with Sasaram Mufassil P.S. Case No.595 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
