The petitioner seeks bail in Barahara P.S. Case No. 323 of 2013, corresponding to Sessions Trial No. 142 of 2014, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 304B and other Sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the husband of the deceased.

It appears from the perusal of the report that nine prosecution witnesses have already been examined, but thereafter a petition was filed on behalf of defence to recall prosecution witness. It appears that the trial is at the fag end.

Considering the facts aforesaid, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner above named on bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

The trial court is directed to expedite the trial and conclude the same within three months from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.
