3 17-03-2015 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 387, 379, 323, 341, 354 and 506/34 of IPC.

It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case due to land dispute. He has also filed case due to land dispute. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for other side submits that the petitioner is a habitual offender and he has several criminal antecedents.

Considering the facts and circumstances, the above

named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Ghanshyam Singh, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Patna/court concerned in Ram Krishna Nagar P. S. Case No. 193 of 2014 **after framing of charge** with following conditions:-

1. The petitioner will not indulge himself in similar or any other offence.
2. One of the bailors must be the close relative of the petitioner.
3. The petitioner will be well represented in the Court on each and every date and in case of absence for two consecutive dates or in case of violation of terms of bail, his bail bond would be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
