ORAL ORDER

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5 18-05-2015 Learned counsel for the petitioners, in presence of learned State Counsel as well as learned counsel for the private Respondents, submits the present writ petition pertains to a dispute under the provisions of the Bihar Consolidation of Holdings and Prevention of Fragmentation Act, 1956, which is a scheduled Act under Section-9 of the Bihar Land Tribunal Act, 2009. Accordingly, a prayer is being made for transmitting the record of the case to the Bihar Land Tribunal.
