Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner being the husband of the
complainant is apprehending his arrest in a complaint case wherein
process has been directed to be issued after cognizance being
taken for the offences punishable under Section 498A of the
Indian Penal Code and 3/4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

The basic accusation is of torture for non-
fulfillment of the dowry demand.

Though, the matter was referred to the Mediation
Centre on the joint prayer of the parties but it appears from the

report of the Mediator dated 30.07.2015 at Flag 'A' that the prayer was made for extending the period of mediation.

The petitioner and the complainant are present.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready to keep the complainant as wife with full dignity and honour. Though, statement to that effect has not been made in the petition.

Counsel for the complainant submits that the complainant is ready to accept the offer of the petitioner.

Both sides agree to appear before the learned court below on 29th of October, 2015 when the petitioner will take the complainant to keep her as wife with full dignity and honour.

Considering the present stand of the parties, let the above named petitioner be released on provisional anticipatory bail for one year in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Complaint Case No. 2266 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

The provisional bail of the petitioner will be

confirmed within one year by the learned court below in three eventualities:- (i) on substantial restoration of the matrimonial harmony; (ii) or if the complainant gets reluctant to reconcile the issue; and (iii) or if the complainant fails to appear before the learned court.
