ORAL ORDER

It appears that the petitioner had twice moved the Court earlier and still he is claiming payments from the respondents. To cut short the matter, learned counsel for the parties do not object, if the petitioner is

directed to file a fresh representation with regard to all his remaining claims before the authority concerned along with material in support thereof so that the same be disposed off by passing a reasoned order within a fixed time frame.
