The writ application seeks a direction upon the respondents to name the road as Bithauli Jale road in place of Atarbel Jale Raod.

On bare reading of the prayer, it appears that a public cause is being sponsored by the petitioner. Counsel for the State with reference to the Annexure-A to the counter affidavit submits that a Public Interest Litigation vide C.W.J.C. No. 2077 of 2013

was filed seeking the similar relief in which no relief was granted to the petitioner of the said case.
