2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the
offences alleged under Sections 498A, 341, 323, 379, 504,
34 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the D.P. Act registered in
connection with Ashok Paper Mill P.S. Case No. 138 of
2013, arising out of C.R. No. 2036 of 2013.

falsely implicated and reiterates his commitment to keep
