In view of the cause shown by Collector,

Bhojpur at Arrah, Opposite Party No. 4 asserting that the name of the petitioner from the panel stood deleted in terms of the instructions contained in Memo No. 12 Headquarters dated 18.06.1995, copy whereof was served on the petitioner on 06.07.1995, the order under contempt could not have been passed, as such fact was stated in the counter affidavit filed in the writ case, may be giving an

incorrect date of removal of the petitioner.

I see substance in the show-cause and I am not inclined to proceed any further with the contempt application, which is disposed of. Petitioner, if so advised, may assail the action of the respondents in accordance with law.
