Appointment on the post of Anganbari Sevika is not an appointment under the State. It is an engagement of a kind of contract on a fixed kind of remuneration. The right of the petitioner for consideration is based on the policy and guidelines. If the petitioner does not fulfill the requirement or if she incurs a disqualification by being the daughter of the ward, where the selection is required to be made, who are barred from such selection, the non-selection of the

petitioner seems to be in conformity with the policy.

Writ application is dismissed.
