The petitioner apprehends arrest in Sitamarhi Sadar
Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes Police Station (SC & ST
PS) Case No 28 of 2013 instituted under Section 420 of Indian
Penal Code and Section 3 (1) (X) of SC & ST (Prevention of
Atrocities) Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is the Pramukh and the informant is a Member of the
Panchayat Samiti who is alleged to have resigned from the Samiti
but contests the same. It is as a fall out of political differences that
this case has been lodged, inter alia, alleging that his letter of
resignation is forged. The petitioner called his caste name and
abused. Essentially, the difference is political dispute.

Be that as it may, in the event of his arrest or surrender
within four weeks from today, the petitioner abovenamed shall be

released on bail on his furnishing bonds of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sitamarhi in Sitamarhi SC & ST PS Case No 28 of 2013 dated 19.08.2013 subject to all conditions as laid down in Section 438 (2) of Criminal Procedure Code.
