Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and

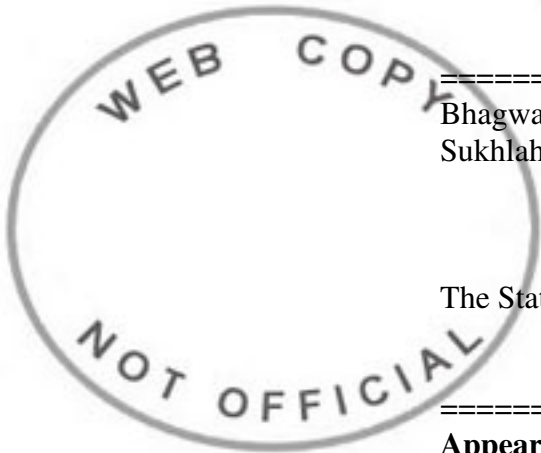
the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
19.09.2014 in a case registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 272, 273, 290, 409/34 of the Indian Penal Code and 47(a)
of the Excise Act.

Hundred litres of country made liquor was
recovered from the hutment of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the hutment does not belong to the petitioner and
admittedly, there is no recovery from the petitioner.

Considering the quantity of recovery and the



period under custody, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, Raxaul at Motihari, District – East Champaran in connection with Darpa P.S. Case No. 92 of 2014.

Since the petitioner is accused in four other cases, the learned court below will positively cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner, if he defaults for two consecutive occasions.
