Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the informant and the State.

This is a petition for grant of regular bail for offence under Sections 304 and 201/34 of the Penal Code.

The petitioners are mother-in-law and father-in-law and there is general and omni bus allegation of subjecting cruelty. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the husband of the victim-deceased was living separately in a rented house.

Hence, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with **S. Tr. No. 610 of 2014** arising out of Rivilganj P.S. Case No. 47 of 2014 to the satisfaction of the **Additional Sessions Judge, XI, Saran at Chapra.**
