State.

The Petitioner No.1 seeks release in Revilganj P.S. case
No.51 of 2014 (J.J.B. No.1269 of 2014) instituted for the offence
under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 302 and 504/34 of the Indian
Penal Code, pending in the court of Juvenile Justice Board, Saran
at Chapra.

Having perused the report of the Juvenile Justice Board,
Saran at Chapra that the enquiry is likely to be concluded within
five months, I am not inclined to release the petitioner No.1.
